To achieve these aims, the project will have three results, including:

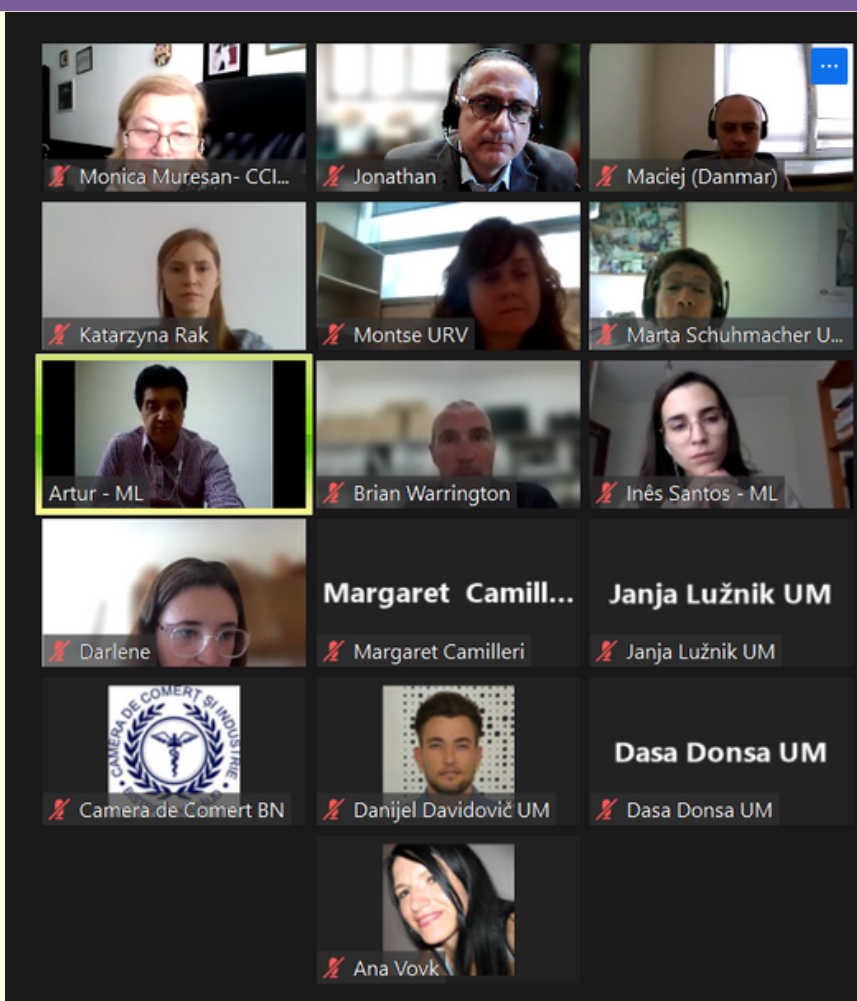
1. A Guide for VET providers to Foster Circular Economy Entrepreneurship with SMEs

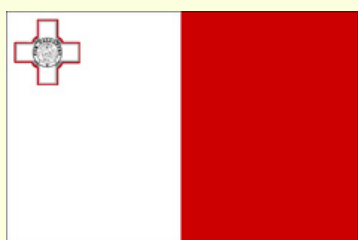
DISCERN Kick-Off Meeting
